**Monday:** "A good intention requires the support of a good action in order to translate into a positive outcome!"-Trishna Damodar. Have you ever met someone who appears to have good intentions...but their actions or outcome just doesn't quite hit? This coming Sunday in our "Great Is Thy Faithfulness" series we will dig in with the fact that God is faithful in His promises. God not only has made great and precious promises, He has the ability to follow through on every single one of them. Father, thank You for Your great faithfulness. As we keep studying the truth behind the old hymn, keep our heart singing louder than ever as we truly discover just how great is Thy faithfulness. In Jesus, amen.

**Tuesday:** "His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and goodness. Through these He has given us His very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires (2 Peter 1:3-4)."
